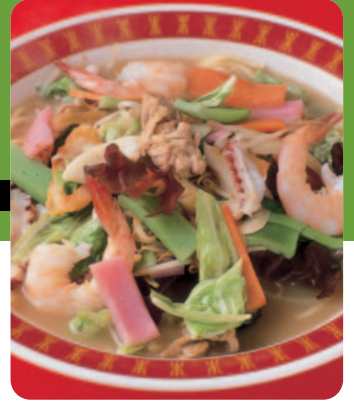

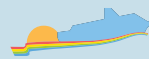

Han: **I'm visiting Oura Cathedral today. And if it's sunny tomorrow, I'll probably go to Shimabara.**

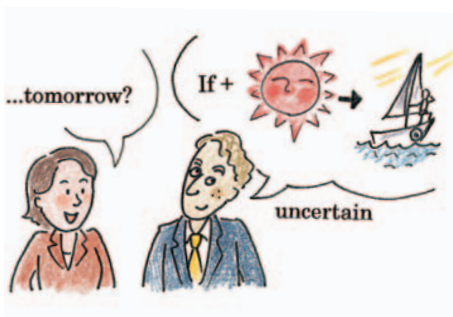

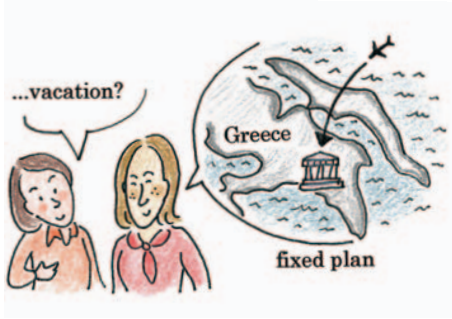

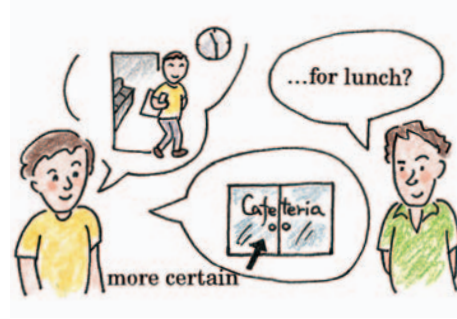

電車の発着時刻やコンサートの開催日時など、滅多に変わることのない予定についてはWh-疑問文で尋ねることができます。動詞は通常、現在形を用います。答えるときも現在形ですが、willを使って未来形にすることもできます。また、未来の事柄について話していることが明らかな場合は、時を表す表現は必要ありません。

A: When is the next train for Hiroshima?

B: It leaves at 9:27.

A: Which platform does it arrive at?

B: It'll be at Platform 9.

個人的な予定について話す

「What are your plans (for+時間/イベント)?」や「Have you made any plans (for+時間/イベント)?」、「What are you [doing/going to do] (+時間/場所)?」のような質問に答えるときは、次のような構文を使うことができます。

●予定が未定の場合

「(If ...,) [I might/I want to/maybe I'll]+動詞」のように言うことができます。

If it's a nice day, I might go to the beach.

I want to find a good place to eat local food.

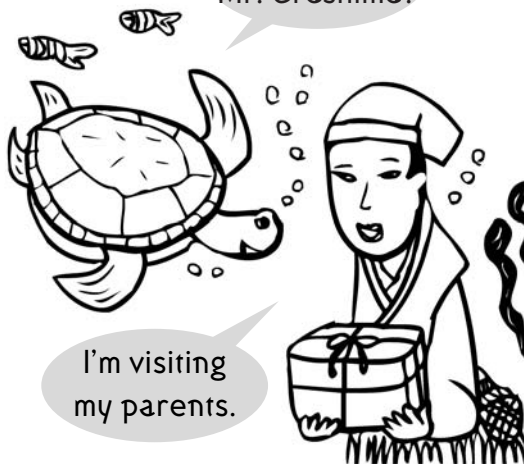
If I have time, maybe I'll visit Shimabara.

●予定がほぼ決まっている場合

「(If ...,) I'll (probably)+動詞」のように言うことができます。

I'll probably visit Glover House.

What are you doing tomorrow, Mr. Urashima?



●予定が決まっている場合

「I'm going to+動詞」あるいは「I'm+動詞ing」のように言うことができます。また、definitelyを使って予定が決まっているのを強調することもできます。

I'm going to attend my friend's wedding there.

I'm visiting my grandpa in Sasebo.

I'm definitely trying the hot springs in Unzen.

I hope you have a good time.

Conversationの中で、BethがHanにI hope you have a good time.と言っています。この他、同じような状況で使える表現には、(I hope you) enjoy yourself.や(I hope you) have a [nice/good/great] day.などがあります。返答は、Thanks. You too.と言うだけで構いません。
